BAYSWATER STATION PEDESTRIAN CROSSING CLOSURE – SOUTHERN SIDE ONLY

Access to Bayswater Station via Whatley Crescent will close permanently from Thursday 15 September 2022, to construct new railway lines.

Where:

The pedestrian crossing between the station platform and Whatley Crescent (see map).

What to expect:

- Permanent closure of the station entrance from Whatley Crescent only.
- Station access from Railway Parade only – via the station pedestrian crossing (east) or the station pedestrian tunnel (west).
- To cross the rail line, pedestrians and cyclists can use the King William Street subway and the Leake Street underpass.
- Advance notice will be provided if ever one of the two rail crossings must temporarily close to safely deliver works. At least one rail crossing will always remain open.
- Please plan for additional travel time to access the station and follow detour signage
- There will also be changes to the shared path detour along Railway Parade and Whatley Crescent (refer to on-road signage).
