## METRONET NEW BAYSWATER STATION PROJECT - 24/7 WORKS

From late-September, 24/7 works (including on public holidays) are required for the New Bayswater Station Project in the lead-up to and during the Midland Line Shutdown in early-2023.

We understand out-of-hours works can be disruptive and make every effort to minimise impacts.

### What we are doing:

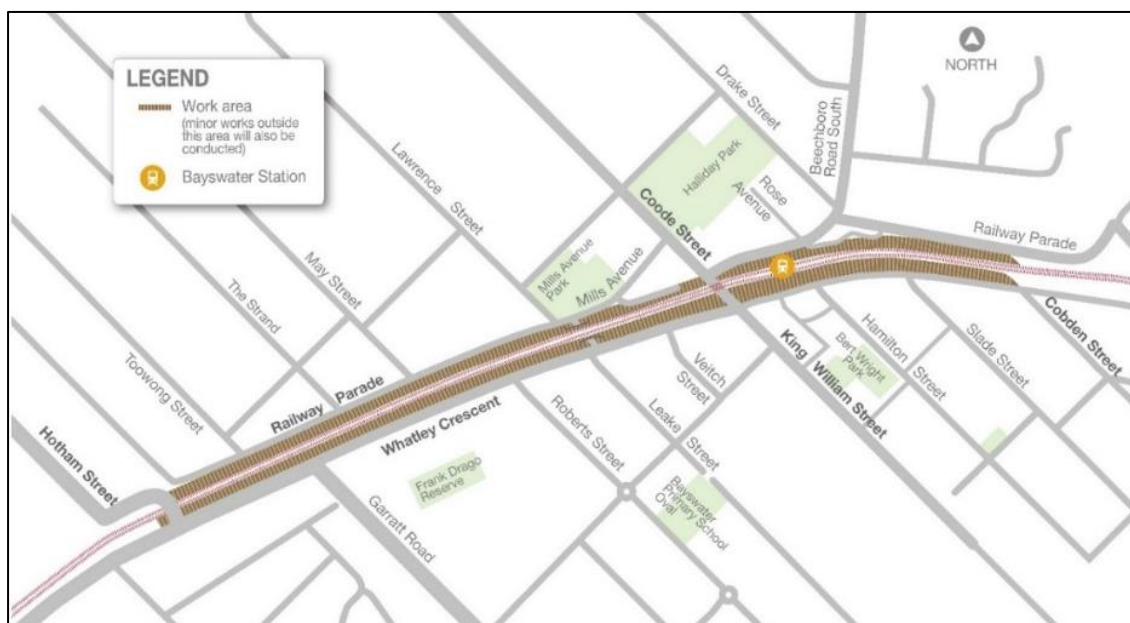
- Earth works including excavation, trenching and soil removal / relocation
- On-site delivery of machinery and materials
- Installing foundations and masts for overhead line equipment
- Rail cutting, removal and replacement using welders, grinders and rail saws
- Realigning rail track over new bridges
- Bridge deck and track slab works
- Installing formwork and erecting steel structures
- Concrete pours
- Station construction
- Installing precast concrete-box culverts for the upgraded Leake Street pedestrian underpass.

### When:

- From late-September 2022 until early-2023
- 24/7 works from Monday–Sunday, including public holidays

### Where:

- Various locations between Cobden–Hotham streets on both sides of the rail line (see map):



**What to expect:**

- Noise levels will vary depending on the activity. High-level noise activities will take place during the day or earlier in the night, where possible.
- Vibration and dust levels will depend on the equipment used and proximity to the work area.
- We are managing noise, vibration, and dust with the following measures:
  - monitors in place as required
  - loud music prohibited at night
  - voice levels kept low
  - equipment switched off or throttled to a minimum, where possible, when not in use
  - Reversing vehicles using squawkers instead of beepers
  - Water carts and street-sweepers to manage dust and sand
- Lighting towers will be in use after-hours
- Frequent access to local roads to deliver, install and remove material and equipment.

**Traffic impacts:**

- Changed traffic conditions including road closures and detours
- Leake Street underpass will be closed from Saturday 24 September–Sunday 9 October
- Pedestrian and cyclist access to the station, or across the rail line, via King William Street
- The shared path detour will be redirected via the Leake Street underpass if ever a temporary closure of King William Street is required to safely deliver works.

**Midland and Airport Lines disruptions:**

- Cancellation of **nightly** services to safely deliver works:
  - Sunday 2 October–Thursday 6 October (Midland Line only)
  - Monday 5 December–Thursday 8 December
- Cancellation of **weekend** services to safely deliver works:
  - Friday 11 November–Sunday 13 November
  - Friday 9 December–Sunday 11 December
