Lane closure and traffic impacts

7 to 21 August

Temporary lane configurations and restricted turning movements on Coode-King William streets and Whatley Crescent

What we are doing

- preparing for permanent road changes to Coode-King William streets and Whatley Crescent including raising the road level, installing traffic signaling and asphaltting
- out-of-hours works to remove existing traffic signals, install temporary traffic barriers and make lane modifications on Coode-King-William streets
- earthworks, drainage works and water main installation.

When

- out-of-hours works from 8pm to 5am Thursday 10 August to Monday 14 August
- Whatley Crescent eastbound lane closed from Monday 7 August and extended until Monday 21 August.

Where

- Whatley Crescent eastbound lane closed between King William Street and Garratt Road (**see *detour map overleaf***)
- no right-hand turn from Coode Street (southbound) into Whatley Crescent (westbound)
- left-hand turn entry and exit into the Halliday Park car park via Coode Street (southbound traffic).

What to expect

- noise, vibrations, dust and intermittent out-of-hours works
- signalised pedestrian crossings on Coode-King Williams streets relocated south of Mills Avenue and north of Murray Street – traffic controllers in place to safely assist pedestrians
- pedestrian access along Coode-King William streets via designated walkway with overhead cover
- nightly service disruptions to the Midland and Airport lines from Saturday 6 to Thursday 10 August, and Sunday 13 to Thursday 17 August
- service disruptions to local bus routes 48, 999, 998 and rail replacement buses 901 and 902

About the project

The new Bayswater Station will improve connections across the railway, cycling and pedestrian access, complementing the town centre and connecting the Midland, Airport and Morley-Ellenbrook lines for travel directly to the Airport, Swan Valley region, CBD and beyond.
