What we are doing

- Ongoing road works to Coode-King William streets and Whatley Crescent including raising the road level and asphaltting
- During works, some unexpected and ageing underground pipes were discovered requiring extra time and care.

When

- Whatley Crescent eastbound lane closure extended until Friday 25 August.

Where

- Whatley Crescent eastbound lane closed between King William Street and Garratt Road
- No right-hand turn from Coode Street onto Whatley Crescent
- No right-hand turn onto King William Street from Whatley Crescent
- Left-hand turn only from Coode Street into and out of the Halliday Park car park

What to expect

- Out-of-hours works
- Noise, vibrations and dust
- Heavy machinery, equipment and workers accessing the area
- Light spillage
- Service disruptions to local bus routes 48, 999, 998. Visit transperth.wa.gov.au to plan your journey.
