New Bayswater Station project works

What we are doing

- Halliday Park drainage works including excavation, installation of underground storm water tanks and reinstatement
- ongoing retaining wall and noise wall construction and backfilling along Railway Parade
- drainage works on Leake Street
- service relocation and water main installation along Whatley Crescent
- road works throughout the precinct including Rose Avenue. Works will include asphaltting, curbing and line marking
- construction of pedestrian access from Hamilton Street to new Whatley Crescent extension road including installing stairs, balustrades, and handrails
- station building works on the northern station area including earthworks, roadworks, concreting, steel fixing and delivery of materials to site.

When

- out of hours works will take place throughout October
- a section of Whatley Crescent between Slade and Cobden Street will remain closed until November
- the northbound lane on Leake Street will be closed from mid-October until November
- Rose Avenue works will take place until December
- Halliday Park works will continue into early 2024.

What to expect:

- during Halliday Park works the southern section of the park will be temporarily inaccessible to park users, the work area will be secured via temporary construction fencing. (See map on back page)
- access for residents on Rose Avenue will be maintained
- northbound lane closure on Leake Street between Whatley Crescent and the rear laneway
- there will be no footpath closures and entry and exit to shops will not be impacted during works on the Whatley Crescent pedestrian link. A narrowed footpath will be utilised to maintain access
- eastbound lane closed on Whatley Crescent between King William Street and Garratt Road
- noise, dust and vibration due to drainage installation, station building works and construction of retaining and noise walls
- sand and dust will be managed with the use of water carts and street sweepers as required
- reversing vehicles using squawkers instead of beepers, use of lighting towers and workers in the area
- equipment switched off or throttled to a minimum, where possible, when not in use
- trucks delivering, loading and unloading materials.

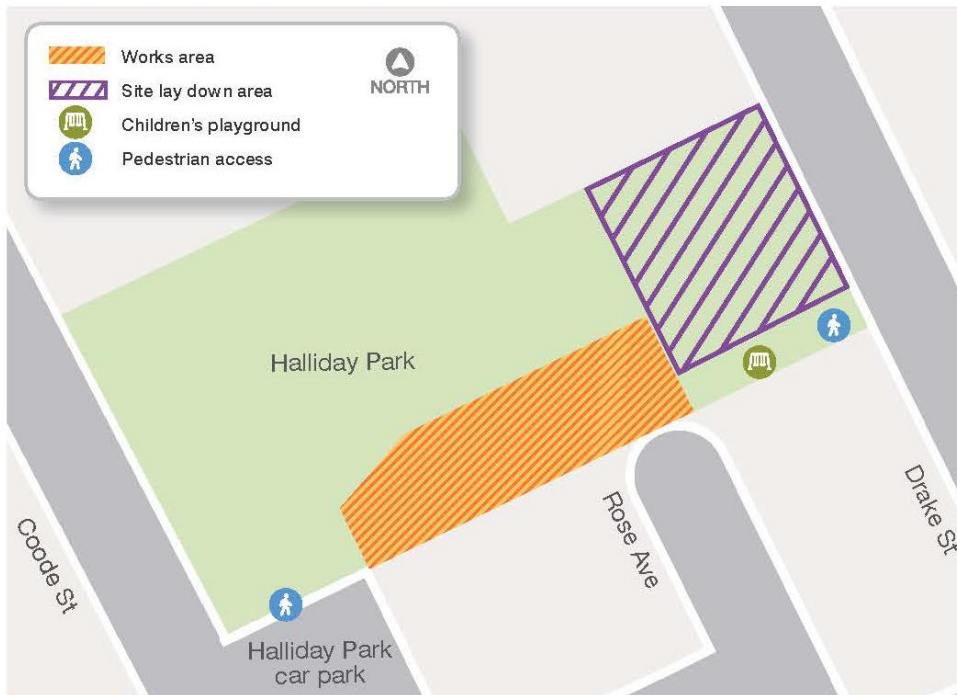
