New Bayswater Station project works

What we are doing:

- ongoing noise wall and retaining wall construction including excavation, concreting, handrail installation and earthworks along Railway Parade, Whatley Crescent and Coode Street. Pedestrian access via the western footpath on Coode Street between Railway Parade and Burnside Street.
- artwork installation in the Leake Street Underpass. Pedestrian access maintained
- ongoing station building works on the northern station area including installation of services, fixtures, lighting and cladding, painting, tiling, steel fixing and ceiling works
- ongoing bridge and abutment work including concreting, welding, scaffolding, backfilling, post-tensioning and installation of concrete platform planks
- landscaping works including paving, excavation, installation of irrigation, structural soil which will protect tree roots and trellis' which will support climber plants
- footpath reinstatement works along Coode Street and Railway Parade including concreting.

Shared path works

- shared path works between Meltham Station and Cobden Street including drainage installation and remedial works
- removal of the old temporary on-road path diversion along Whatley Crescent
- removal of old infrastructure including speed cushions and signage on Railway Parade.

Drainage works

- drainage installation through trenching and excavation along Railway Parade east of Beechboro Road South, and Coode Street
- Halliday Park drainage works including earthworks, the installation of underground storm water tanks, irrigation works, backfilling and turf reinstatement.

Road works

- works include asphaltting, kerbing, paving, line marking, spray and sealing, resurfacing, drainage, verge and median works, and streetlight installation
- road works throughout the precinct including:
 - Rose Avenue
 - Whatley Crescent
 - Hamilton Street
 - Railway Parade between Lawrence and Coode streets
 - Beechboro Road South between Railway Parade and Drake Street
 - Coode/King William streets
 - Leake Street

Public Transport Authority

- Slade Street
- Drake Street.

Traffic disruptions (refer map overleaf)

- changed traffic conditions including intermittent lane closures and contraflow arrangements including:
 - nightly eastbound lane closures Whatley Crescent between King William Street and Garratt Road from 8pm to 5am for road works
 - westbound lane intermittent closures on Railway Parade between Hotham and Lawrence streets. Local access maintained
 - Railway Parade closed between Lawrence Street and Mills Avenue for asphalt resurfacing works. Local access maintained
 - Railway Parade cul-de-sac lane closures for drainage and pavement works
 - changed lane configurations on Coode Street and King William Street, between Murray and Burnside streets for retaining wall, bridge, landscaping and road works.
 - intermittent changed lane configurations on Whatley Crescent extension road, between King William and Drake streets for abutment works
 - lane closure on corner of Hamilton Street and Whatley Crescent for road resurfacing works. Access to Hamilton Street car park and Bayswater Police Station maintained.

When:

- between Friday 1 December to Friday 22 December
- out-of-hours works will take place throughout December
- all site works will stop over the holidays between Saturday 23 December 2023 to Monday 1 January 2024 (inclusive)
- lane closure on the corner of Hamilton Street and Whatley Crescent until mid-December
- intermittent contraflow arrangements along Coode/King William streets until mid-December
- intermittent contraflow arrangements will be in place along the Whatley Crescent extension road, with corresponding no right hand turn into Rose Avenue until late December
- Railway Parade lane closures between Hotham and Coode streets until late December
- the westbound lane on Railway Parade will be intermittently closed until late December
- Railway Parade and Rose Avenue works will take place throughout December
- Halliday Park works will continue into early 2024.

What to expect:

- traffic detours and traffic management in place
- during Halliday Park works the southern section of the park will be temporarily inaccessible to park users, the work area will be secured via temporary construction fencing.
- access for residents on Rose Avenue and the Railway Parade cul-de-sac will be maintained
- a section of footpath of the south-east side of Beechboro Road will be closed to facilitate abutment works. A pedestrian detour will be in place around the northern side of Bayswater Station
- noise, dust and vibration due to drainage installation, station building works, road works and construction of retaining and noise walls
- sand and dust will be managed with the use of water carts and street sweepers as required
- trucks delivering, loading and unloading materials.

Rail disruption:

To facilitate these works, services on the Midland and Airport lines will be cancelled:

- from last service Friday 15 December until first service Monday 18 December 2023.
