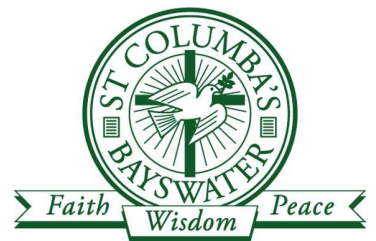


NAPLAN - Reading mean score comparison

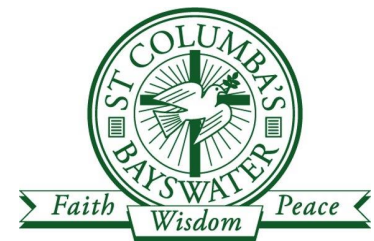

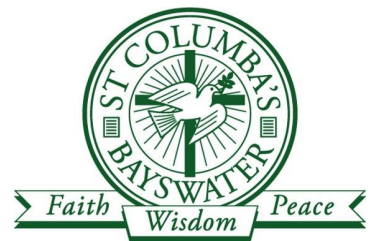


NAPLAN - Spelling mean score comparison Year 3

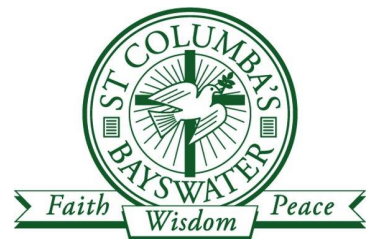

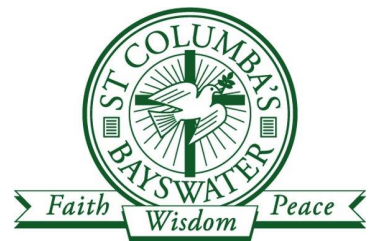


NAPLAN - Grammar mean score comparison

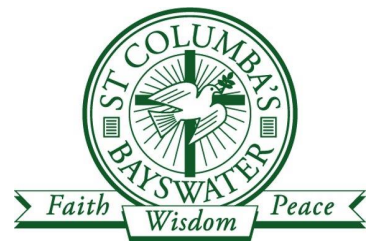
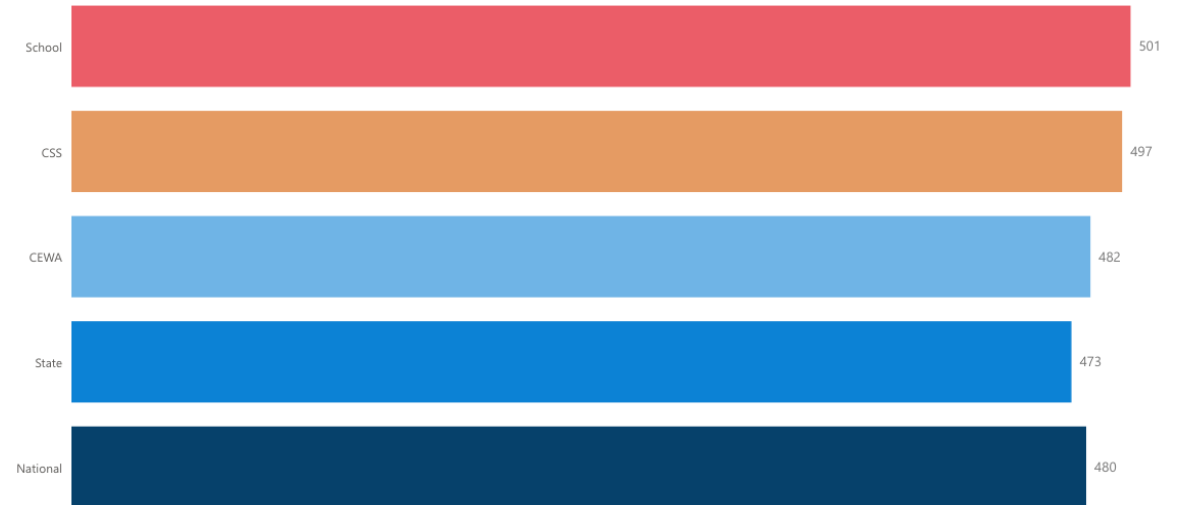


NAPLAN - Writing mean score comparison Year 3

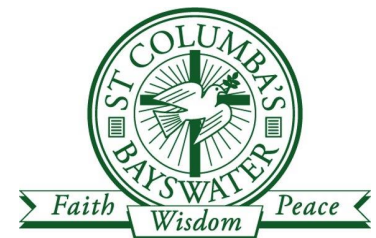

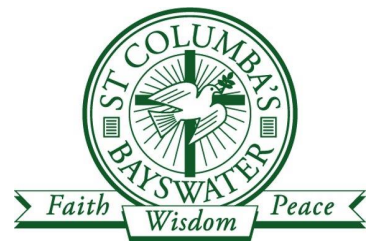


NAPLAN - Numeracy mean score comparison
